3. Club Operations

Juniors - Rose:

Rose will discuss the process of the communications with Erin and pass on any information Erin may require.

Tournaments:

2023 Winter Classic – December 30th, 2023 at the Big Marble Go Center. Will use the same format as last year. Morning will be Intermediate with a cap of six teams and

afternoon will be the Open with a cap of six teams. Teams can consist of any mixture – two ladies, two men, or mixed. \$35.00 a person.

Motion by Linda – 2nd by Noel. Carried - To wrap up the tournament name "Renato Franchetto Memorial" after this year as it has been ten years, and call it the Winter Classic.

26th Annual Barrie Shave Tournament

Motion by Linda – 2nd Noel. Carried – To wrap up the tournament name "Barrie Shave Memorial" after this year as it has been 25 years, and call it the Father's Day Classic.

With the change of name, discussion took place of possibly scaling the tournament back in certain ways which could include not raising funds for the Margery Yuill Cancer Centre. When a tournament co-ordinator is in place more discussion will take place as to what the options may be.

Was mentioned that perhaps we send out letters early January to our donors letting them know about the change in format. We would still ask for donations and have a donor board up for the donations that we would receive.

Maintenance & Capital Projects

The clubhouse is now closed. Nets on Courts 4 and 5 are in rough shape and need to be replaced. Ken will contact the city.

Noel and his helpers will redo the floor in the clubhouse during the winter.

Noel is looking into putting a screen up on the south end of the back deck so when we have our tournaments, and if we have entertainment, the sun can be blocked so people are not looking into the sun.

The cost of the new lights will be \$46,000. Ken is waiting to hear back from the CFEP grant.

Was decided to have the Try Tennis Event every other year as our social media seems to be working well.

The City Singles Tournament will wrap up on Sunday Medicine Hat Open Singles and Doubles Tournament will run Wednesday to Sunday Members Social will go Thursday, June 6 instead of Friday. Rest of schedule basically remains the same as last year.
